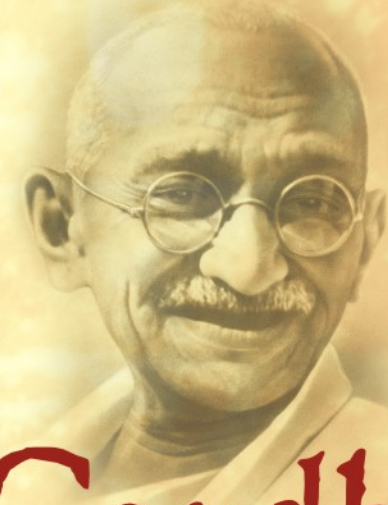

College Profile

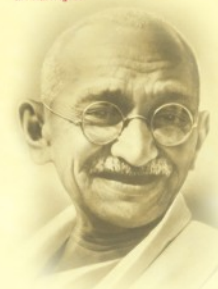
