Terms and Conditions

- Registration is free.
- The competition will be divided into two factions.

Group – 1: Classes 5 to 10 Group – 2: Class 11 to Post Graduate (Open)

- The same email id and mobile number can be used for registration and submission only once. Please enter your email ID carefully.
- The person participating in the competition will be given an ID number and password by the GRF.
- Candidates should have a valid personal e-mail ID and mobile number. It should be kept active during the entire competition. Registration number, password, and all other important details will be sent to the same registered e-mail ID.
- Hindi, English and Marathi languages are to be used in the Solo Acting competition.
- ▶ The video should range between 2 5 minutes.
- Your video must be made for this competition only.
- Your video must not have been submitted anywhere else before and it must not have been shared on any social media.
- There should be mention of any personal, ethnic, state or social defamation in your script.
- Harm should not be done to any animal or nature during the acting, and it should not be objectionable in any way.
- To accompany the acting, costumes, music or instruments can be used, but this is not mandatory.
- The candidate is responsible for copyright issues regarding the music, script or dialogue used in the video.
- Violation of the above prescribed rules will lead to your registration being canceled.
- The selected videos will be shared by the GRF on https://www.youtube.com/c/GandhiTeerth and https://www.facebook.com/gandhiteerth/
- > The jury's decision will be rated as 60% and 'likes' on social media as 40%.
- The decision of the selection committee will be final and Gandhi Research Foundation has the right to make any necessary changes in this competition.
- The Gandhi Research Foundation has the right to share and use the videos received in the competition.
- As a participant in the Competition, you are bound by all the above terms and conditions.







Guidelines for the video

The following information is to be furnished before commencing the video;

In the National Solo Acting Competition organized by Gandhi Research Foundation, I..... (name, village, taluka, district, state) school (if applicable) ... group (1st or 2nd) (Title of the video) (If applicable, you can name the script writer, technical guides, assistants, directors, etc.)

- > You cannot use recorded scripts.
- We may ask for your written script, if required.
- > The video format should be MP4.
- If you are recording your video from a mobile, it should be kept horizontal.
- > The file size of the video should not exceed 700 MB.
- > You can use a mic and headphones.
- > Do not move your mobile phone while making the video.
- The video should be shot in bright light, with a good background, in a quiet environment and with a clear voice.
- Before uploading the video, personally, check that it is before the deadline, and that your internet is stable
- While uploading the video, have your student ID card / Aadhar card, passport size photograph ready. With the help of the username and password given in the email received in your registration acknowledgement, submit the video by logging in http://www.gandhifoundation.net/GRF_EVT2021
