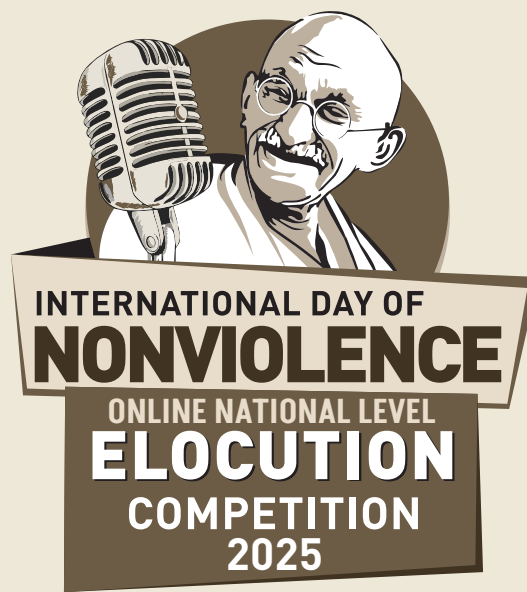

Terms & Conditions

I. About the content:

- Each participant can submit only one video speech for the contest;
- Duration, four minutes maximum;
- The video can be shot using a mobile phone or any other camera;
- Video orientation should be horizontal;
- The participant can speak in one of the two languages: Hindi or English. Mixing languages is not allowed;
- The presentation should start with the following introduction: "I am.....(name)..... resident of (village/city, District and state), studying(standard)..... at (school/college)..... happy to be a part of the online elocution competition conducted by the Gandhi Research Foundation on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti 2025, would like to speak on(theme)....."
- The speech must be confined to the theme. Wrong or controversial information will make the candidate liable to being disqualified;
- The candidate should not read a written message, but speak directly into the camera;
- The speaker should be clearly visible in the video, the audio must be clear and without any external interference;

- The video must be recently recorded exclusively for this competition. It should not have been submitted for any other competition or event nor have been already published;
- Once your video is ready, then fill your online registration on <https://forms.gle/bi9r1KbxmiWj1han9>

II. Registration and submission:

- Online registration form should be uploaded with completed giving all the required information including with 1 ID proof - (any one of the Gov approved identity documents such as: Aadhar card, Passport, etc.) or Institution Identity Card
- Last date for submission of the videos is: 18.09.2025 (including the first level of the third group)

III. Selection Process:

- The clips selected by the juries from among all the video clips received till the last date will be eligible for the final prize and the same clips will be uploaded on the GRF's official social media (Facebook, YouTube and Instagram) by Gandhi Research Foundation on 22.09.2025.
- The final winners will be selected on the basis of 'likes' received by the video as well as the scores given by the examiners. (90% marks obtained by Jurors and 10% marks for social media)

- The official link for each video will be sent to the respective candidates for their online campaign in seeking 'likes' and comments;
- The final results will be declared on 02nd October 2025, published on www.gandhifoundation.net

IV. Honours

- All participants will receive an online certificate of participation;
- The prize money will be credited to the winning candidates' bank account.

V. Statutory

- The Jury's decision will be final;
- The GRF holds the right to publish the videos in their other media in future;
- The registered candidates are considered to have agreed to the terms and conditions of the contest;
- The GRF can exercise its discretion in adjusting the norms and pattern of the contest, if required.
