Terms & Conditions

I. About the content:

- Each participant can submit only one video speech for the contest;
- Duration, four minutes maximum;
- The video can be shot using a mobile or any other camera;
- Video orientation should be horizontal;
- The participant can speak in one of the three languages: Marathi or Hindi or English. Mixing languages is not allowed;
- The presentation should start with the following introduction:
"I am.....(name)..... resident of
(village/city, District and state), studying
.....(standard)..... at (school/college)..... happy to be
a part of the online elocution competition conducted by the
Gandhi Research Foundation on the occasion of Gandhi
Jayanti 2020, would like to speak on(theme)....."
- The speech must be confined to the theme. Wrong or controversial information would invite disqualification;
- The candidate should not read a written message, but speak directly to the camera;
- The speaker should be clearly visible in the video, the audio must be clear and without any disruption;
- The video must be newly recorded exclusively for this competition. It should not have been submitted for any other competition or event nor have been already published;
- Once your video is ready, then fill your online registration on <https://forms.gle/WFN6JHB2xJJzcQ8W9>

III. Registration and submission:

- Online registration form should be uploaded with complete information along with
 - ID proof – (any one of the Gov approved identity documents such as: Aadhar card, Passport, etc.) or Institution Identity Card
 - Video file.
- Last date for submission of the videos is as follows:
 - 1st Group : 28/09/2020
 - 2nd Group : 29/09/2020
 - 3rd Group : 30/09/2020

IV. Selection Process:

- The submitted videos will be evaluated by a Jury panel appointed by the GRF;

- The videos, approved by the panel, will be uploaded on the GRF's official social platform (**facebook, youtube and instagram**) on the following dates:
 - 1st Group : 02/10/2020
 - 2nd Group : 03/10/2020
 - 3rd Group : 04/10/2020
- The official link for each video will be sent on the same day; to the respective candidates for their online campaign in seeking 'likes' and comments;
- Candidates may circulate only the official link (provided by the GRF) to their audience, and not their videos directly;
- 'Likes' received at the official link alone will be considered for merit.;
- The winners will be chosen, based on the number of 'likes' and comments received from the online viewers and the scores given by the Jury;
- The final results will be declared on 09/10/2020, the last day of the Nonviolence week and published on www.gandhifoundation.net

V. Honours

- All participants will receive an online certificate of participation;
- The winners will receive a cash prize as stated above.

VI. Statutory

- The Jury's decision will be final;
- The GRF holds the right to publish the videos in their other media in future;
- The registered candidates are considered to have agreed to the terms and conditions of the contest;
- The GRF can exercise its discretion in adjusting the norms and pattern of the contest, if required.
