Phase 2 : Methods and techniques of sustainable reconstruction (5 credits)

Phase 3 : Development and welfare models and experiences (5 credits)

Phase 4 : Internship for six weeks (5 credits)

Working days : Six days a week

Field-work : Two days a week (Thursday & Friday)

Exposure : 20 days visit to front-line campuses that offer pioneering leadership for sustainable rural reconstruction)

Term II

Duration : Six months - January 5, to July 15

 - Organizing the villagers and enabling them for reconstruction /development
 - Initiating PRA based SWOT analysis
 - Designing smart solutions
 - Executing them comprehensively

Output : Successful candidates will be offered placement by the GRF in selected villages

Terms : Candidates are to commit themselves to work for SRR in the GRF's selected villages

Daily schedule : Yoga, community work, community prayer, spinning, academic sessions, library work, hands-on experience, journal writing, evening session with thematic discussions/ debating/ presentations/film documentaries, etc. on campus.
