

Duration : Six months - January 5, 2020 to July 15, 2020

Inputs :

- Stay in a chosen village
- Organizing the villagers and enabling them for reconstruction /development
- Initiating PRA based SWOT analysis
- Designing smart solutions
- Executing them comprehensively

Output : Successful candidates will be offered placement by the GRF in selected villages.

Terms : Candidates are to commit themselves to work for SRR in the GRF's selected villages..

Daily schedule : Yoga, community work, community prayer, spinning, academic sessions, library work, hands-on experience, daily diary writing, evening session with thematic discussions/ debating/ presentations/film documentaries, etc. on campus.

Faculties : Besides regular, eminent social entrepreneurs and thinkers invited as visiting faculty.




